

TRANSPORTER BRIDGE WALK RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- An adult guardian must accompany each entrant under the age of 18 to the Transporter Bridge Walk. For school or youth groups, there must be a ratio of 2 adults per 5 pupils. The guardian must sign this form in the place provided.
- A basic level of physical fitness is required to take part in this event.
- Sensible flat shoes or trainers must be worn at all times.
- For health and safety reasons, unfortunately we are unable to allow under 10's or anyone with heart, respiratory or joint problems to take part.
- Once accepted, your place cannot be transferred to any other person. If you cannot attend the Transporter Bridge Walk you must inform Hartlepool and District Hospice as soon as possible; you cannot give your place to any other person.
- Fees: There is no fee to take part in this event.
- Sponsorship: We would respectfully request that you aim to raise a minimum of £50 in sponsorship. Please return your sponsorship monies by 30th November 2009 – If you find it difficult to collect all your sponsorship by that date please send in what you have collected and then send the rest later.
- Time of Arrival: Registration on the day of the event will open at 9:00am at the venue, with the walk commencing at 9:30am.
- Personal belongings: We do not have the facility to store personal belongings, please keep everything with you.
- All participants take part at their own risk. In no event shall Hartlepool & District Hospice be liable for any injuries, loss or damages whatsoever and including indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential losses connected with any aspect of this walk.
